In World War II, at a small RAF hospital, plastic surgeon Archibald McIndoe performed surgery on servicemen suffering disfiguring facial burns. McIndoe, faced the monumental task of restoring not only skin but flesh, and bone structures, and rebuilding his patient's self-esteem and will to live. He developed a ground breaking approach to rehabilitation, creating a therapeutic community in the hospital, and its town of East Grinstead. Convinced that the affection of women was essential to the men's recovery he recruited nurses who were beautiful and humourful. The men named themselves McIndoe's (surgical) 'guinea pigs' and formed the now world famous Guinea Pig Club. As a child growing up in East Grinstead, Dr Byrski was terrified by the appearance of the Guinea Pigs. Decades later, she returned to learn more about McIndoe's patients, his nurses and their life in the town. *In Love and War: Nursing Heroes* is the story of that journey and of the people Dr Byrski met along the way.

Dr Byrski is the author of ten best-selling novels including *The Woman Next Door, Family Secrets,* and *Gang of Four*, and more than a dozen non-fiction books including *Getting On: Some Thoughts on Women and Ageing.* Her books and articles have been published internationally. She also holds a PhD from Curtin University where she is an Associate Professor in the in the School of Media, Creative Arts and Social Inquiry and the Director of the China Australia Writing Centre. She has also worked as a journalist, an ABC broadcaster and was a Senior Policy Advisor to a Minister in the Western Australian Government and a former President of the WA Women's Advisory Council to the Premier.
