Something has gone wrong. Repeated polling proves there has been a dramatic loss of faith in our politicians and in politics. Is the public's mood justified?

Yes – it is. The perception is that there is endemic, intractable misfeasance and even corruption in our public and governmental institutions. There is reality in the perception – Australia's international integrity standings has continued to slide. Meanwhile there is less transparency, giving rise to more misgivings about opaque transactions, some of which appear to have been made between politicians and their friends.

It is not just money at stake. Recent governmental actions and transactions have diminished Australia's standing in the international community – important diplomatic ties are fraying. Specifically, the unexaminable contracts in relation to the management and treatment of refugees and prisoners have placed lives at risk. These effects are not imagined, they are real.

What is going wrong? And what should be done?

GEOFFREY WATSON SC is a barrister based in Sydney with a national practice. Much of his experience has been in the area of anti-corruption law, regulation and oversight of government agencies, including law enforcement. He is a director of the Centre for Public Integrity and an Adjunct Professor at the University of Notre Dame. Mr Watson teaches and writes in the area of anti-corruption law, the law of tort, and legal history.
